Albright College has five main computer labs for general student use, and sixteen specific use labs.

Center for Computing and Mathematics

The Center for Computing and Mathematics (CCM) building hosts the main computer labs on campus. The five general use labs (100A, 100B, 100D, 100E, 100F) provide 65 IBM-compatible computers running Windows XP with Microsoft Office 2003, Internet access, printing and scanning capabilities. Among these 65 machines are 26 computers (100D and 100E) that can be booted as MAC OS or PC Windows machines. The 100A computer lab contains 3 Sun Sparc Workstations that can be accessed by Computer Science Department students. Regular semester hours for the CCM labs are:

Mon.– Thurs. 8 am – 1 am
Friday 8 am – 6 pm
Saturday 10 am – 6 pm

Science Hall

Science Hall provides another general use lab with 20 IBM-compatible computers running Windows XP with Microsoft Office 2003. These 20 machines also have Internet access and printing capabilities. Hours for the Science Hall computer lab are as follows (except when a class is in session):
